Purpose	To provide quality physiotherapy and rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities (PWDs) and other patients at the Rehabilitation Centre for Persons with Disabilities (RCPD) Kotli. The Physiotherapist will assess, plan, and implement evidence-based physiotherapy interventions aimed at improving patients’ mobility, functional independence, and overall quality of life under the supervision of the Physiotherapist and Health Lead.
Main Responsibilities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Conduct physiotherapy assessments and develop individualized treatment plans for patients. 2. Provide therapeutic interventions including exercise therapy, manual therapy, electrotherapy, and rehabilitation techniques. 3. Support rehabilitation services for persons with disabilities, including musculoskeletal, neurological, pediatric, and geriatric cases. 4. Maintain accurate patient records, treatment notes, and progress reports in accordance with organizational standards. 5. Educate patients and caregivers on home exercise programs and rehabilitation practices. 6. Ensure proper use, care, and maintenance of physiotherapy equipment and materials. 7. Coordinate with the rehabilitation team and other health professionals for integrated patient care. 8. Participate in community outreach activities, screening camps, and awareness sessions when required. 9. Prepare monthly activity reports and contribute to program monitoring and documentation. 10. Adhere to professional ethics, MH-MSDS (Health), safeguarding policies, and organizational guidelines.
